

Anique Apitities Program STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- 6-14 years old
- Student has diagnosis of Autism, Down Syndrome or other developmental/cognitive disability.
- If nonverbal, student must have communication device and RBT.
- Any RBT will be required to provide background check verification.
- Any RBT must meet with director prior to starting.
- · Student will participate in therapies.
- Student will engage in daily hands-on activities.
- Student is potty trained.
- Student has no self-injurious behaviors.
- Student has no tendencies to harm others.
- Student is able to remain in learning environment for up to 15 minutes without requiring a "brain break."
- Student requires minor assistance with lunch.
- Parents will provide any updated neuropsychology evaluations or information about new medications.
- Student will attend one Friday at minimum per month.
- Student will maintain an 80% attendance rate.
- Student will be in school from 9 AM-1 PM at minimum.
- Parents are to attend monthly parent prayer groups.
- Parents are to attend progress meetings each semester.
- Students are to wear navy blue or khaki shorts or pants with school polos purchased from PCA.
- Each family is to obtain one company to sponsor the program within the school year.
- Each family is to love, value, and respect all other families in the program, as well as any family at PCA.
